Description: Assists the Plant Operator with operations of the surface and ground water treatment plants. Monitors water treatment and distribution system. Makes necessary adjustments to maintain the reliability and integrity of the water supply system.

Duties: 1. Monitors the telemetry and SCADA systems, using the information to control reservoir valves, booster pumps, and wells to distribute finished water throughout the system as needed by customers. 2. Detects and reports indicators of system malfunctions. 3. Monitors and makes the prescribed laboratory analysis of raw and finished water to determine the proper treatment. 4. Operates and regulates chemical feeders and other equipment to obtain the desired product in the most economical manner. 5. Keeps records of laboratory analyses, chemicals used, gallons treated, etc. 6. Makes reports and calculations as prescribed by the Water Supply Superintendent. 7. Conducts regular inspections of the plant and reports any malfunctions. 8. Assumes responsibility for and takes immediate action to assure the delivery of adequate, safe, potable water. 9. Answer routine questions from customers pertaining to water issues. 10. Conducts regular tours of treatment plant for visiting groups or individuals. 11. Carries out all responsibilities until a relief operator has arrived and has been briefed on current operating conditions. 12. Complies with all pertinent ADEM and EPA regulations. 13. Performs additional duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Education/Training/Certifications: High School graduate or equivalent with a concentration in chemistry, math, hydraulics and computers preferred.

Must obtain the ADEM Grade IV Water Certification within one (1) year of being hired and/or promoted into this position and maintain certification.

Experience/Skills: Laboratory/chemistry background preferred. Equipment: Chemical feeders, pumps, laboratory equipment, electrical controls, motor starters, computers, SCADA, Laboratory equipment, water testing equipment.
